



National Exhibition Gouda 2019 Extract of the regulations

Article 1: GENERAL

April, 17-20 2019. Sports-complex De Mammoet, Calslaan 101, 2801 RT Gouda.

The exhibition (ca. 700 frames) will be organized by the foundation Stichting Filatelistische Evenementen of Gouda.

Article 2: THE EXHIBITION

Opening hours:

Wednesday evening April, 17, 18.00 – 21.30 hrs

(only for participating dealers, exhibitors and donators!)

Thursday April, 18 10.00 – 17.30 hrs.

Friday April, 19 10.00 – 17.30 hrs.

Saturday April, 20 10.00 – 16.00 hrs.

It is an exhibition with international participation. Categories 1, 2 and propaganda.

Classes: traditional, postal history, airmail, astro philately, open class, thematic philately, revenues, one frame, postal stationery, maximaphily, picture postcards and literature.

Class 2: For competition class, minimum three and maximum seven frames.

Class 1: For competition minimum four and maximum eight frames.

On Friday April, 19 there will be a festive palmares evening in Hotel Van der Valk, Nieuwerkerk a/d IJssel (12 minutes by car from De Mammoet) from 18.00 – 22.00 hrs. The ticket for the evening costs € 50. This includes dinner, soft drinks, beer, house wine and inland spirits. A ticket has to be booked beforehand from the organizer, at the latest by March, 20. The number of seats is limited, so please book on time.

Article 3: THE ORGANISATION COMMITTEE

The organization will deal with good security. The exhibitor has to take care of and is responsible for his own insurance.

The organizer will take good care of the collections, but will not be responsible for any damage or loss.

Article 4: APPLICATION AND ALLOTMENT OF EXHIBITS

For each entry a separate application form is needed. For all competition classes a plan has to be sent at the same time, at the latest before November, 15, 2018 to: SFE c/o Gijsbrecht van Dommelen, Frankenstraat 26, 2582 SL Den Haag, Nederland or secretary@sfeg.nl. Applications for competition classes without plan will be declined.

Allotting of applications will take place at the latest on December, 31, 2018. An invoice for the frame fee will be sent at the same time. The invoice has to be paid within two weeks. When payment has not been received on time, the organisation is entitled to allot the frames to exhibitors on the waiting list.

The frame fee for all classes (including propaganda) is::

€ 20,00 for 1 frame (as well as literature)

€ 45,00 for 3 frames

€ 52,00 for 4 frames

€ 62,00 for 5 frames

€ 72,00 for 6 frames

€ 77,00 for 7 frames

€ 87,00 for 8 frames

The Dutch frame size is 98x98cm nett. These frames will fit 12 sheets classical wide size or 15 sheets A4. All sheets need to have plastic protecting covers.

Article 5: JUDGING

Judging will take place according to the rules of the Fédération Internationale de Philatélie (FIP), GREV and SREV.

It will be possible to have a discussion with the judges on Saturday, April, 20 according to the roster. This is only possible in case the exhibitor has applied for this on the application form.

The judging team can dedicate honorary awards.

Certificates, point lists and medals will be handed out on Saturday, April, 20 at a time to be announced in connection with taking along the collection, or will be send afterwards together with the collection.

Article 6: THE EXHIBITORS

- An exhibitor has to be a member of a society linked to the Dutch Federation KNBF or a foreign Federation, member of FIP.
- The exhibitor needs to be owner of the collection for at least two years.
- One can exhibit under pseudonym, but the real name of the exhibitor must be known by the organisation.
- It is possible to hang in (and take off) the collection by the exhibitor in person.
If not, the exhibit can be send to the organisation. We will handle it for you with great care, but are not responsible for any risk, including storing and sending back. The cost of the return shipment should be paid beforehand.
- On Saturday, April, 20, immediately after the closure of the exhibition the collection can be taken out of the frames, only after approval by the organisation.
- In case the collection has not been received on time, the organisation can decide not to exhibit this collection.
- There are no circumstances that the collection can be taken away earlier.
- Paid frame fees will not be returned, except for cancelling at the latest two months before the start of the exhibition.
- All exhibitors will receive a medal, a catalogue and one ticket for the evening opening on April, 17. This ticket is personal and identification is obligatory. Extra tickets (as a donor) are for sale at € 30.
- The exhibitor agrees in placing the plan of the exhibit on the website of the foundation www.sfeg.nl, unless you will not allow as mentioned on the application form.
- By sending in the application form, you agree with the regulations.

Article 7: CONCLUSION

- Exceptional, the organisation committee has the right to deviate from the regulations.
- All matters not in the regulations can be decided by the organisation committee.
- Communication with exhibitors will be done per e-mail.
- In the event of any discussion, the regulations in Dutch will be leading.
